On September 22, 1975, a field inspection was made of the above well site, the following conditions were found:

1. $5\frac{1}{2}$ " casing, reduced to $2\frac{7}{8}$ " tubing, protrudes $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet above ground level.
2. One 2" gate valve at top of tubing, and one 2" plug valve extending horizontally.
3. There are no gauges.
4. There is no leaking of oil, gas, or water.
5. The area is not fenced or covered.
6. The original drilling mud pit approximately $75' \times 75' \times 6'$ is empty and clean, and should be filled and leveled.
