DETAILS OF WORK

The well was plugged March 27, 1960 by filling it with heavy mud from the total depth to the bottom of the surface pipe (5535-185). A 10 sack cement plug was set in the bottom 30 feet of the surface pipe 185-to 155, then the casing was filled with heavy mud to within 20 feet of the top. A 7 sack cement plug was set in the top 20 feet of the surface pipe (31 to 11).

All measurements are taken from the kelly bushing which was approximately 8 feet above the ground.
