DETAILS OF WORK

Cast iron bridge plug at 4780'. Plugged back with pea gravel, 4780-4710'. Placed 5-sack cement plug, 4710-4680'. Shot casing loose. Recovered 104 jts., 3271', of 5½" casing. Kept hole full of heavy mud. Placed 10 sacks of cement, 132' to 102'; mud, 102' to 30'; 5 sacks of cement, 30' to surface.

Left 1608' of 5½", 15.5# casing in hole, 3271' to 4879'.

Left 132' of 8-5/8", 15# surface casing in hole.
