✓ Dear Mr. Morrell,

Due to the number of changes in operators regarding the Gebauer Lease and the personnel expansion in the Buckhorn/Exeter transition, some confusion evolved in regard to well identification. After a complete overhaul of our records and a field inspection, the following has been ascertained: The 1-A, 2, and 2A-28 Gebauer are all the same well.

On 4-4-80, this well had a bridge plug set at 4729' (above 'D' sand perfs), and one sack of cement was dumped on top. On 9-22-80, a Halliburton plug was set at 160' and three gallons of cement were set on top. On 9-23-80, the 4½" casing was filled from 160' to surface with 17 sacks of common cement. On 1-27-82, the 8-5/8" and 4½" casing were cut off four feet below ground level, and a steel plate was welded on top. The hole was filled in and the location cleaned.

Plugging and Abandonment Procedure (2A-28 Gebauer)

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- ~~1.~~ Dump 6 sx sand on top of wireline BP set @ 4890' and across perfs @ 4820'-4855'.
- ~~2.~~ Dump 5 sx cmt on top of the sand.
- ~~3.~~ Fill the 4½" O.D. production casing with mud-laden fluid.
- ~~4.~~ Run free point, cut, and pull the 4½" O.D. csg.
- ~~5.~~ Spot 25 sx cmt across 8-5/8" O.D. surface csg shoe (set @ 106').
- ~~6.~~ Spot a 10 sx cmt plug at the surface.
7. Cut the surface csg off 4' below G.L. and weld a lid on top.
8. Clean and restore the location.

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
