In work that affects only rods, pumps or tubing or other routine work such as, but not limited to, cleaning out to previous total depth, no report is necessary.

Perforations at 4955 to 4958 feet were squeezed off with 240 sacks cement and new perforations placed at 4960' to 4962' by Schlumberger measurement. New perforations acidized with 500 gal. M.C.A. (Mud Acid) resulting in 5 million cu. ft. gas (estimated) with slight show of oil and less than 1/2 Bbl. water per hr.
