Gentlemen:

In accordance with Commission Rule No 325, Okmar Oil Company herein makes application for permission to dispose of the water produced from the Huey Wells No. 12, 22, 29 and 37 into Okmar's Huey Well No. 16. These wells are located in Sections 20, 29 and 31, T. 2N., R. 56W., Morgan County, Colorado, and are in the Burr and Peterson Fields.

This letter and its attachments, which constitute application, are submitted in triplicate and the following information furnished as required:

- (a) Attached is a plat showing the location of the proposed disposal well (Okmar's Huey No. 16), the location of all oil and gas wells, including abandoned and drilling wells and dry holes, and the names of all owners of record within one-half mile of the Huey No. 16.
- (b) Injection of produced water into Okmar's Huey No. 16 will be through perforations from 5178' to 5185' in the Dakota "D" Sand formation.
- (c) Attached is an "Abridge-A-Log" of the Schlumberger Electrical log of the proposed disposal well on which the existing perforations in the 5½" casing are illustrated.
- (d) The Huey No. 16 has 5½", 14#, J-55 casing cemented at 5293' with 125 sacks. Since this well is presently producing with no downhole problems, additional testing at the casing is not anticipated upon conversion to a disposal well.
- (e) The water to be injected into the Huey No. 16 will be water produced from the Dakota "D" Sand formation in Okmar's Huey Wells No. 12, 22, 29 and 37.

- (f) The estimated minimum and maximum volume of water to be injected into the Huey No. 16 are 675 barrels per day and 1,000 barrels per day, respectively.
