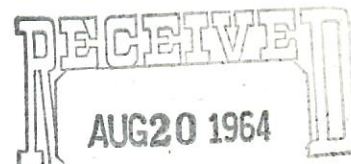

The following report covers the W. G. Rogers-#B-1 Warren,
C SW NW Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 49 West,
Washington County, Colorado.

The subject test was drilled to total depth of 3976 feet,
approximately 52 feet below the top of the 'J' sand. A
core was cut in the 'D' sand from 3834 to 3872 feet. Good
oil-stained sand was recovered from 3852 to 3860 and 3861
to 3871 feet. Above oil shows tested water on drill stem
tests.

No showings of oil or gas were observed in the 'J' sand.

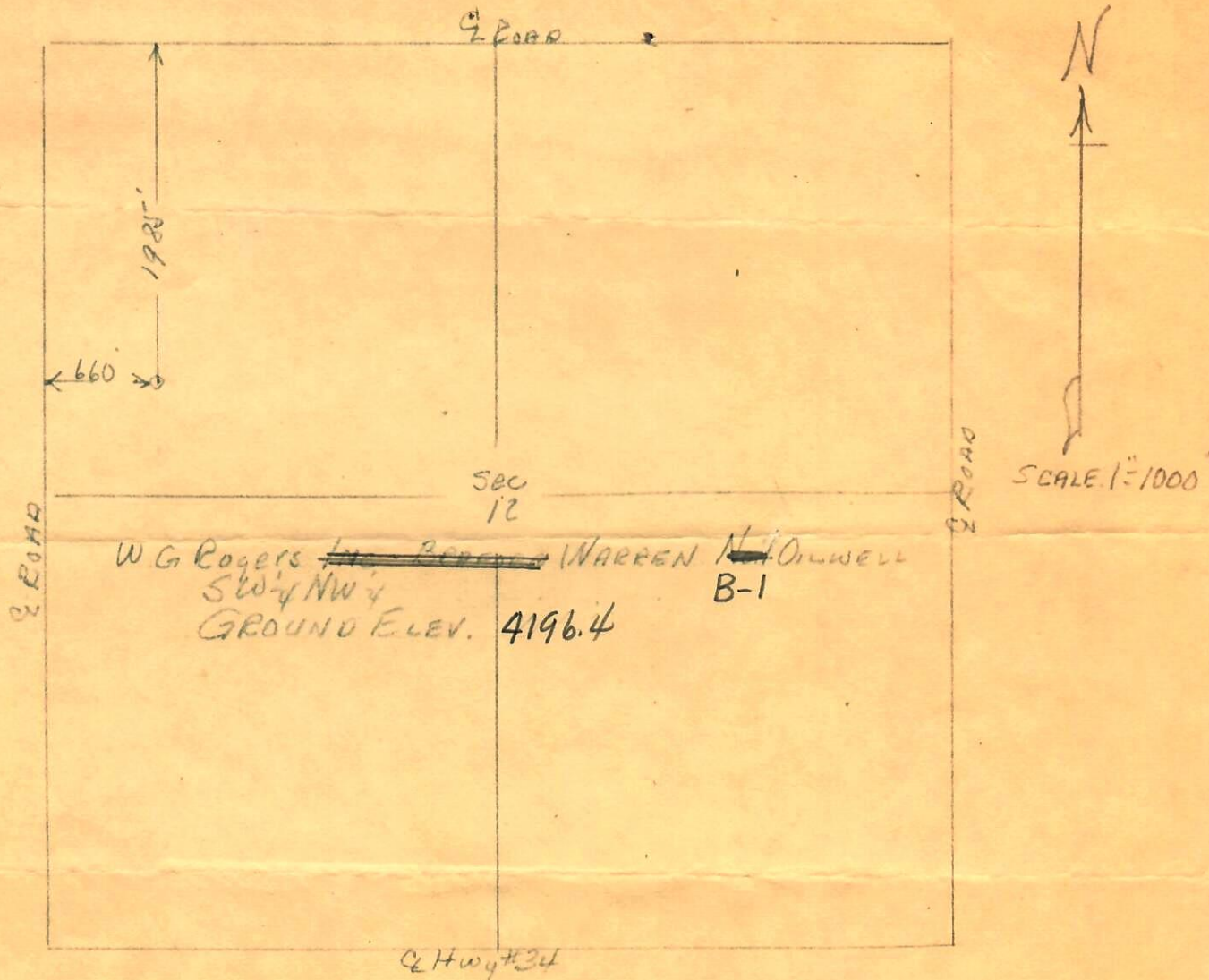
