Operator Comment: Foundation inherited this PA well in a 2016 acquisition. Foundation never operated the well and does not have any field personnel in this area. Soil sampling will be completed by a third party consultant within the next 30 days. A Form 19 will be submitted if impacts are identified by the lab analytical results. There was no stained soil

shown in inspection photos to support the statement that there is evidence of a historical release on location.
