Dates cannot be solidified until we have a permit in hand, but I would hope we could have that by end of January and move forward with the first well in late February or early March.

Each well takes approximately 10-14 days as long as there is no unknown junk in the hole or mechanical issues from the previous P&A.

Yes, those arrows are where the ECMC has them shown based off of the old lat/longs. I had a typo, it is the Dryer 32-1 not 31-1.

As an FYI, we will be moving the drilling rig onto our County Line pad for development of this unit in the next week or two. These P&A wells will not hold up drilling progress as they are required to be mitigated prior to completions ops not drilling.

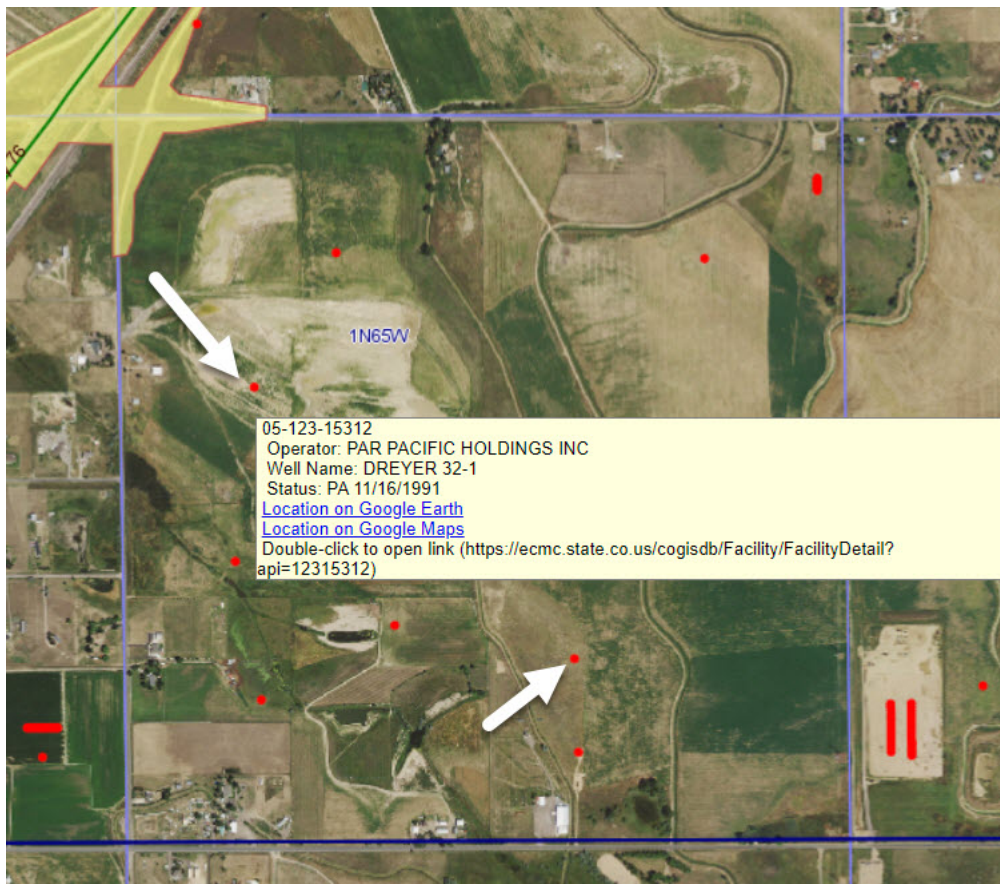

Hello Jason,

As we proceed with the County Line 3229 development we are required to reenter and replug the Sawyer #32-34 in the W2SE 32 1N65W and Dreyer #31-1 in the SWNW 32 1N65W on South Weld Holdings property. This work will require a workover rig to enter the property and complete the necessary work in a 10-14 day period utilizing daylight hours only. Please let me know if you have a preferred access point or questions. I would like to have a surveyor enter the property with a metal detector to look for the underground well and expose it by digging a hole with a shovel. Once found, we will submit the location to the state in order to gain a permit for the work.

Let me know if you are alright with our surveyor entering the property to start the process.
