

The Well is located 330 Ft. (N) of Section Line and 330 Ft. (E) of West Section Line.

The elevation above sea level is 4356 Ft.

As per verbal permission granted by Mr. A.J. Jersin, March 23, 1955, the above mentioned well has been plugged and abandoned in the Skull Creek after encountering no shows of any commercial value in the geological column. Total depth was 5550' and the method of plugging was as follows: The hole was filled with heavy drilling mud and a cement plug placed below and in the 8 5/8" surface casing. A steel cap was welded over the casing.
