We ^{propose} to drill this well with rotary tools to a depth sufficient to
 test the "D" and "J" sands of the Dakota series. The approximate total
 depth will be 5650 feet. We expect to reach the top of the "D" sand at
 approximately 5400 feet, and the top of the "J" sand at 5500 feet. We
 will set and cement sufficient surface casing to protect the hole and
 surface bearing water sands. In the event formations are encountered
 carrying oil or gas, or both, in commercial quantity, casing will be
 run and cemented to total depth.
