INSTRUCTIONS

Before any person shall commence operations for the drilling of any well, such person shall file with the Director an application on Form 2 for a permit to drill, along with a filing and service fee of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75), and must secure the Director's approval before proceeding with such operation. Wells drilled for stratigraphic information only shall be exempt from paying the filing and service fee.

Before any person shall commence operations for the deepening of a well to any source of supply other than the existing producing horizon or for the reentry of a well, such person shall file an application on Form 2 and secure approval of the Director.

Form 2 shall be filed in duplicate for wells on all Patented and Federal lands, and in triplicate for wells on all State lands. An accurate plat or map showing the location of the well and showing measurements necessary for the determination thereof shall be filed with the Director. Unless operations are commenced within one hundred twenty (120) days after the date of approval, the permit will become null and void; however, for good cause shown, the Director may grant an extension not to exceed an additional one hundred twenty (120) days.
