General Comment:**ECMC Inspection Report Summary**

On Monday, 06/17/2024, Inspector Kirby Burchett, conducted a routine field inspection at Caerus Piceance LLC on the Piceance Creek Unit F23-18G well, Location #315347, in Rio Blanco County, Colorado.

This location is within or in close proximity to a Parks and Wildlife (CPW) District and Black Bear area with High Priority, NSO, and Density Habitat regulations.

Location is shared with 23-18 PWDD water transfer facility.

Any Corrective Actions from previous Inspections are still applicable.

While there during normal operations the following compliance issues were observed:

1. No sign at tank battery.
 2. Relief riser missing protective cap.
 3. Production tank labels missing required information.
 4. March 2024 Production Report. April production report overdue.

A follow up on this site inspection will be conducted to ensure all compliance issues have been corrected to comply with ECMC rules.
