Operator Comments:

KMOG is requesting approval to install a permanent instrument air skid at USA Fed Tank Battery 26C-36HZ (location 431891) to reduce the environmental impact of the facility by using air instead of natural gas to operator pneumatically controlled valves.

A 15hp instrument air compressor skid will be placed on this location. The instrument air skid will serve the facility equipment for the following wells: USA Fed 02C-36HZ, 02N-36HZ, 27N West-36HZ (location 336303) and the USA Fed 01N-36HZ, and 27N East-36HZ (location 336117). These are two separate well pads, the USA Fed 02N-36HZ well pad is located southwest of the facility, while the USA Fed 26C-36HZ is located southeast of the facility.

KMOG will utilize an existing flowline from the facility to USA Fed 02N-36HZ (location 336303) well pad to supply instrument air instead of natural gas to operate the wellhead equipment for the USA Fed 02C-36HZ, 02N-36HZ, 27N West-36H wells.

Additionally, KMOG is requesting approval to install small, permanent micro instrument air skid mounted in a cabinet measuring approximately 3'x5' on the USA Fed 26C-36HZ well pad (location 336117). This will supply instrument air instead of natural gas to operate the wellhead equipment for the USA Fed 01N-36HZ and USA Fed 27N East-36HZ wells.

No additional flowlines will be trenched to the USA Fed 26C-36HZ well pad due to this compressor being set at the facility and the micro instrument air skid being set at the well pad.

This sundry is associated with sundry 403951156.

This equipment is not expected to result in additional traffic, light, or noise impacts to surrounding stakeholders.

KMOG plans to install the new equipment on December 1, 2024.
