OPERATOR COMMENT

This form serves to comply with the Rule 913.e. reporting schedule. The review status of the previously proposed workplan (Doc. # 403862747) is "In Process" on Web Forms. The Operator completed the additional site investigation as outlined on Doc. # 403862747.

Elevated EC was observed in multiple characterization samples used to delineate the magnitude and extent of elevated EC but was not deemed attributable to native soil conditions by the ECMC. Per the COA provided on Doc. #402640641 the Operator submitted a detailed reclamation plan pursuant to Rule 915.b and is requesting an NFA designation be granted with elevated inorganics left in situ.

Supplemental Form 27s will be prepared and submitted on a quarterly schedule to provide updates and progress of the remediation until an NFA designation has been received.
