Photo 1. Facing southeast toward by the wellsite. The area along the road where hydrocarbon impacts were observed have been scrapped and removed.

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Photo 3. The plastic container at the pumpjack is broke and needs to be removed and disposed. Previous CA was not completed.



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Photo 4. There were workers onsite repairing a leak along the flowline. There were oil stained soils at red arrow that will need to be cleaned up.



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Photo 5. South side of the location facing north. There is a pile of material which has hydrocarbon impacts stored with no liner or containment. This appears to be part of the impacted berm material.



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Photo 6. Facing toward the two fiberglass tanks. There is no secondary containment around the tanks which should be empty and not in use without containment.



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Photo 7. Facing toward the tank where spill had previously occurred. There are sampling bore holes shown at red arrow.



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Photo 8. Facing adjacent to the tank. There are still hydrocarbon impacted soils around the entire tank which have not been cleaned up.



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Photo 9. There are still impacted soils around the entire tank where spill had occurred. The tank will need to be removed to excavate and remove all of the impacted soils.



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Photo 10. Facing northwest at the location. The two large volume tanks have been removed. The remaining pipes and barrel will also need to be removed. This area will need to be reclaimed.



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Photo 11. Facing at the north side of the location. The fence around the tank battery is inadequate to prevent livestock entry. The berm around the tank has been rebuilt.
