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Photo 1. The cattleguard at the beginning of the access road has been cleaned out and the material was removed.



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Photo 2. Facing southeast along the access road. Vehicles are causing unnecessary disturbance driving outside of the access road due to stormwater pooling on the road. The access road must be maintained and shall not drive outside of the access road boundary.



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


Photo 4. Facing east toward the wellsite.



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Photo 5. There is still stained soils around the wellhead from a E&P waste spill. It appears there was sand spread on top of the spill which was not cleaned up per the rules. Previous corrective action was not completed.



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Photo 6. This chemical drum has no secondary containment and has been leaking fluids onto the soils which are stained.



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


Photo 8. East side of the location facing west. There are black stained soils shown at red arrow.

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Photo 10. There has been a new electric line trenched which goes to the Rhoades Unit 5-5. The disturbed soils must be seeded and stabilized.
